## Travel

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# **Back Ground**

Promoting the values and employment principles is an important role. The values and principles help people determine how things ought to be done. They guide work practices, interactions and behaviour within an organisation. They are the foundation on which an organisation operates and apply throughout the hierarchy from employer to frontline employee.

Work ethics include not only how one feels about their job, career or vocation, but also how one does his/her job or responsibilities. This involves attitude, behavior, respect, communication, and interaction; how one gets along with others. Work ethics demonstrate many things about whom and how a person is.

Work ethics involve such characteristics as honesty and accountability. Essentially, work ethics break down to what one does or would do in a particular situation. Work ethic is a set of values based on the moral virtues of hard work and diligence. It is also a belief in moral benefit of work and its ability to enhance character.

Workers exhibiting a good work ethic in theory (and ideally in practice) are selected for better positions, more responsibility and ultimately promotion. Workers who fail to exhibit a good work ethic may be regarded as failing to provide fair value for the wage the employer is paying them and should not be promoted or placed in positions of greater responsibility. Values reflect one's personal philosophy in responding to given situation. Values slowly but constantly affect an individual's way of life. Values emerge and change over generations.

# **Objectives of training:**

- To understand the role of values and work ethics in the achievement of organizational goals
- 2. To learn the values and work ethics and its impact on personal and professional life
